Scrutineer Appointment

Each candidate nominated for election may, by written notice given to the Returning Officer, not less than seven days prior to the close of the ballot, appoint a member of the Branch to be a scrutineer in respect of that election, being a member other than a candidate, and may by notice in like manner appoint another such member to carry out the functions of scrutineer where the first mentioned does not carry out those functions.
